

Breakout rooms in Google Meet 10/8/20


Google have released the Breakout rooms feature already. These are the steps to follow to create the environment in your classes.

Within your Google Meet session break in groups for an activity.

Click on the geometric figures icon next to the chat icon



Click on the Breakout rooms icon,



A new window will show your students in the main room and three options on top; rooms shuffle and clear. The basic setup will give you two rooms but you can select a different number based on your activity. You have the option to “Type or Drag” the student’s labels to the corresponding rooms or let the students be assigned a room automatically when you “Create”. The shuffle option could be used if you don’t like the auto selection groups and you want to rearrange your groups randomly. Once you are satisfied with the groups, select create at the bottom of the screen.


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The students will get a link to access the breakout rooms to perform the assigned activity.
