The GPISD Transportation Department Recognized at June Board Meeting

Houston, Texas: At the June 13th Galena Park ISD (GPISD) Board of Trustees meeting, the GPISD Transportation Department was recognized for being named one of the 100 Best Fleets in America.

The 100 Best Fleets in America award is one of the highest honors for Industry and Public Education Transportation Fleets across North America. The program recognizes and rewards peak performing fleet operations in North America. Currently in its twenty-first year, the 100 Best Fleets program identifies and encourages ever-increasing levels of performance improvement within the fleet industry.

To receive this award, the Transportation Department was evaluated in various categories including: Accountability, Use of Technology and Information, Collaboration, Creativity, Evidence of a High Trust Culture, Performance Recognition, Doing it Right the First Time, Efficient Turnaround, Staff Development and Resource Stewardship.

This is the fifth consecutive year the GPISD Transportation Department has received this award. They are also one of only four school districts in the nation to receive this award.
