We wanted to make our parents aware of a new law which affects graduation eligibility for our Mustangs beginning this school year. In 2019, the 86th Texas Legislature established the new requirement for *Texas students to complete a financial aid application in order to graduate*. This past January, the State Board of Education adopted rules related to the new requirement. House Bill 3 required the commissioner to adopt rules that allowed for these new graduation requirements to be implemented.

We want to ensure that all of our Mustangs are eligible to graduate and thus, our College and Career Center will be hosting a virtual informational FAFSA night on Monday, September 27th at 6 PM. The Zoom IS is 4308527045. No password is required. In addition, we will host a FAFSA workshop on Wednesday, October 6th in Room 416 and 418 from 3 PM - 7 PM. We have seen vast improvement in compliance with our Big Three safety initiatives. We thank you for reminding students of the following three before they arrive on campus each day.

1. **ID Badges** - Students are required to wear ID Badges upon entry into the building, upon entry into their classrooms, and when boarding buses going home.

2. **Dress Code** - All students are to comply with the expected Dress Code.
(Specifically no mid-drifts, no backless shoes, no cut offs, no hoodies/hats in the building)

3. **Tardy System** - Students are required to report to their class on time.

- Students arriving after 7:30 a.m. are to report to the attendance office for a pass.

- Students who arrive to class after the tardy bell are to receive a tardy pass.

Our top priority at North Shore Senior High School is student safety. A vital part of student safety at North Shore is knowing who is legally driving and parking on our campus and ensuring that these individuals are supposed to be here. To make sure we can monitor who is on our campus we require parking permits and passes to park at North Shore Senior High school.

Starting 9/27/21, vehicles that park on the North Shore Senior High Campus during school hours without a permit or who are parked illegally will be subject to a boot or device preventing the use of the vehicle.

If the driver does not have the proper driver's license or proof of insurance, the vehicle will only be released to a parent with the proper documentation and a citation may be issued along with a fine.

If the driver of the vehicle does have the proper documentation, a fine will be applied as such:

\$20 for 1st offense.

\$40 for 2nd offense

\$80 for 3rd offense.

\$150 for 4th offense

\$200 for all further offenses
